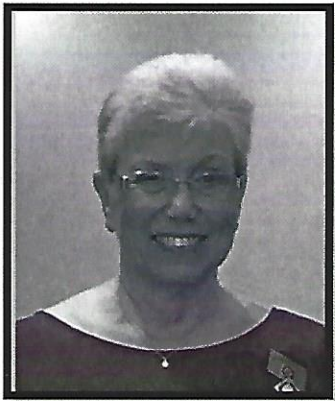


# *District 6510 Governor-Elect*
