Club Constitution and Bylaws

Review your club's current bylaws to ensure they are up to date and applicable to how your club in run and is in compliance with the Standard Rotary Club Constitution which all clubs are obligated to abide by. If your club's bylaws are out of date, you should consider appointing a bylaws committee to review and bring up to date. Please read your President's Manual for guidance. Tip: Most internal club disputes can easily be resolved by the club's current, up to date bylaws. The absence of them creates unnecessary problems.

The Club Budget

Develop a <u>Preliminary</u> working budget for your Rotary club for use during your year as President, keeping in mind that you should consider appointing a committee to work with you after PETS where you can present them with your suggestions and they can give you advise. You should also review the *Financial/Risk Management Best Practices* in your manual. In order to effectively draft a budget for next year, <u>you need to review this year's budget</u> and financial documents. How yo prepare the budget is up to you but you will probably want to at least consider, in no particular order:

**What is your club dues structure based on

- RI dues
- District dues
- Pre-billing for meals
- Invoicing structure (quarterly, semi-annual, annual)
- TRF billing (voluntary sustaining memberships)

**Anticipated miscellaneous income

- Happy Dollars
- 50/50 ticket sales
- Raffle ticket sales
- Fines and other miscellaneous meeting revenue

**Fundraisers

- Charitable
- Club operations (there is a clear distinction between the two)

**Expenditures

- Meal costs
- Venue rental
- Subsidized event costs for you members; RLI, District Events
- Cost of fundraisers (fundraisers have their own budgets)
- Club supplies and other administrative expenses

Service projects

**Keep in mind that your club's fundraising and project events have their own budet.
