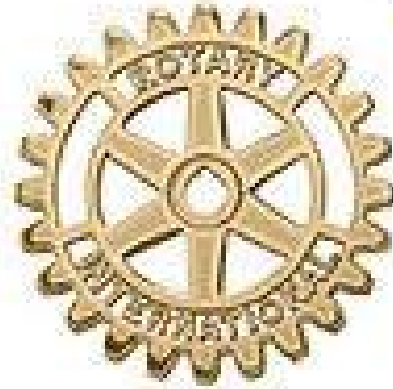

Motivating Club members is to have them realize how important their function is in the broad scheme of the goal.

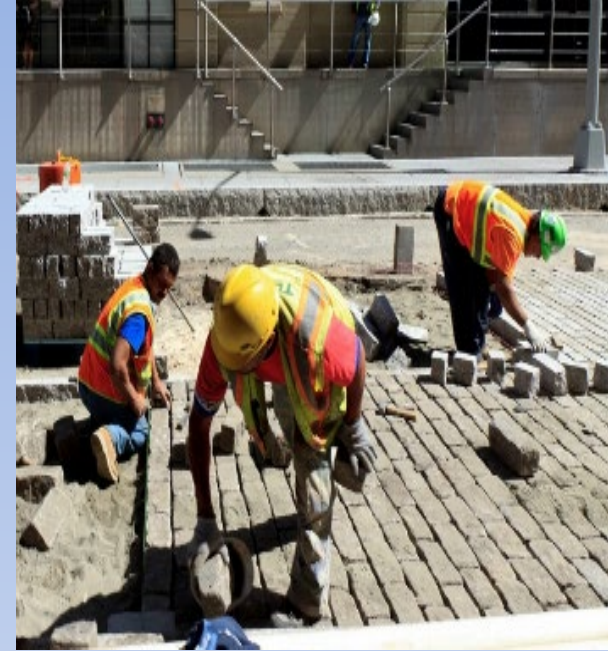
Club Member Motivation (2)

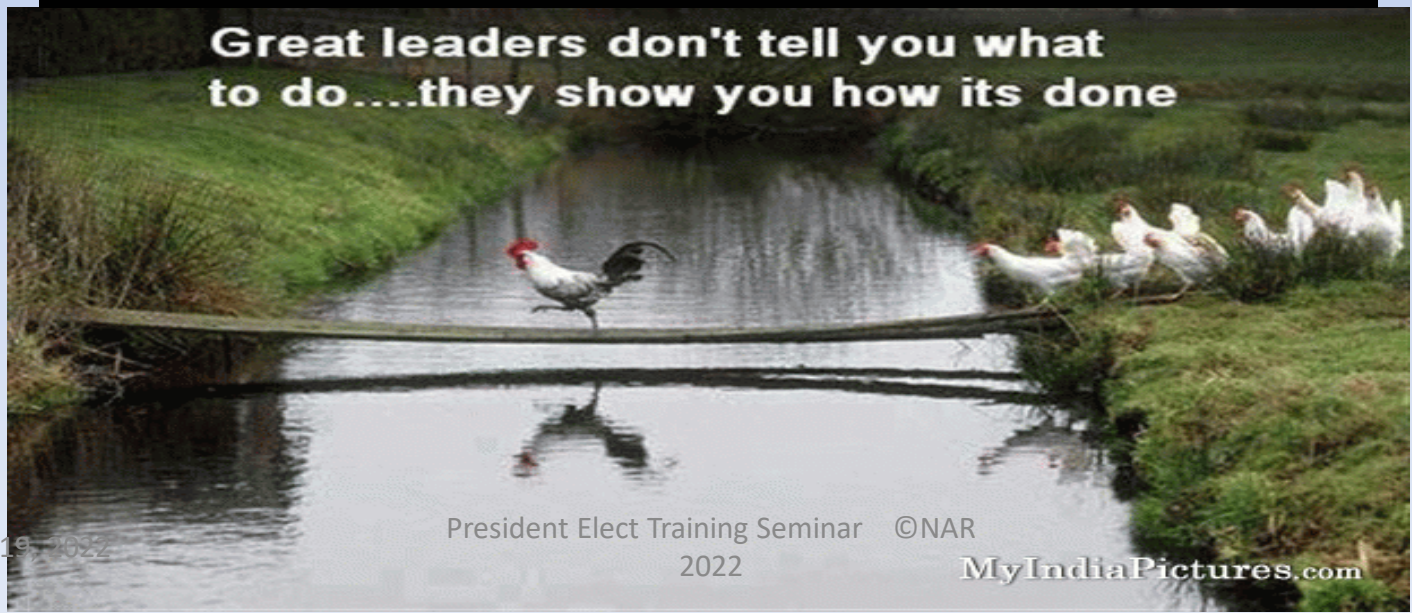
