5. Public Image - Publicize club, social media, etc.

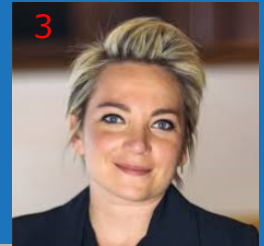
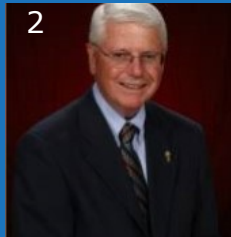
