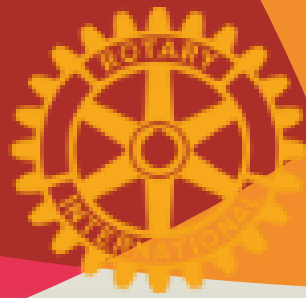

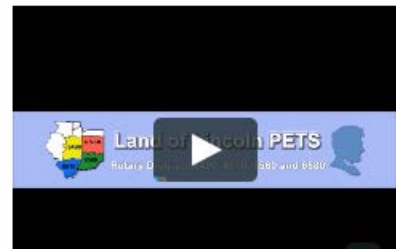

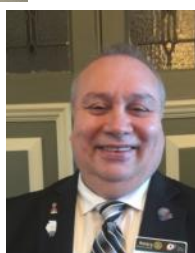
What is the Dress Code at PETS?
