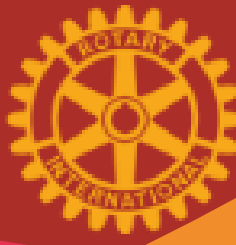

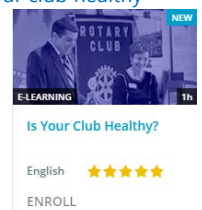
Assignment 5—IS YOUR CLUB HEALTHY

Remember you are representing your club but we want you to be comfortable. There is a small amount of walking between hotel and conference center, so comfortable shoes are recommended.

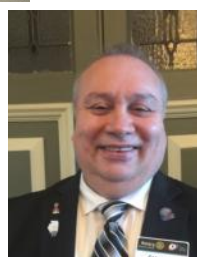
